

ANNEX .GL - SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR THE .GL (cc)TLD

version 2.1 – October 11, 2022

In addition to Gandi's [Domain name registration contract](#), the registration and use of a .GL domain name implies the acceptance of and compliance to the present special conditions contained herein.

All Your legal information and contracts can be viewed at any time via Our [website](#). Capitalized terms have the definition attributed to them in Our [Domain name registration contract](#). Specifically, "You" refers to the owner of the domain name, and "We" designates Gandi.

Section .GL.1. Naming organization

.GL is the official country code Top-Level-Domain (ccTLD) of Greenland. The following diagram presents the various parties involved and the Trustee Authority for the .GL TLD:

Section .GL.2. Registration policies

When You apply to register a .GL domain name, You acknowledge that You have fully understood, and that You certify to have full knowledge of and that You agree to abide by all the rules and specific conditions of .GL domain names, as defined by TELE Greenland A/S, and which may be viewed at the following page:

This contract is binding between You and the .GL Registry. The special conditions contained herein do not replace these rules, but rather form part of them. You acknowledge to have fully understood and accepted these rules on Our website.

Section .GL.3. Special requirements

.GL special requirements are available at:

.GL domain names are open to anyone.

.CO.GL, .COM.GL, .EDU.GL .NET.GL, .ORG.GL are open to anyone, although You need to adhere to the purpose and rules for the types and categories of these third level domains.

The acceptance of Your registration request by the Registry, and so the effective registration of the domain name, may take up to 14 days.

You have to provide and maintain accurate, reliable and up-to-date personal contact information, failing this Your domain name can be delete.

Section .GL.4. Registration term

The registration term is from 1 to 2 years. To avoid any deletion of the domain name, the renewal must be paid and funds cleared **one day before the Expiration date**.

Section .GL.6. Personal data

You consent to the collect, use, copying, distribution, publication, in particular in the Registry public [Whois](#) database if applicable, modification and other processing of Your personal data by the Registry, its technical provider and their designees and agents for the purposes of providing Registry services as defined in the Registry agreement with ICANN and in accordance with the Registry privacy policy.

Section .GL.7. Dispute resolution policy

The Registry does not have any particular dispute resolution policy in place concerning .GL domain names. It is up to the parties involved in the dispute to resolve the dispute between themselves, either amicably or through the courts.

Section .GL.8. Transfer (change of Registrar)

The process is started on Our Interface. Before requesting the transfer of the domain, please be sure that You have the domain's authorization code (supplied by Your current Registrar), and that Your domain name:

- does not have a TransferProhibited status,
- does not expire soon (We recommend that You start the transfer request at least 1 month prior to its Expiration).

The transfer's completion requires Your confirmation (by e-mail).

The transfer of a .GL domain name does not change the domain's Expiration date.

Section .GL.9. Ownership change

The ownership change process is available on Our Interface, it requires the confirmation of the two parties by e-mail.

The owner change of a .GL domain name does not change the domain's Expiration date.

Section .GL.10. Deletion process

One day before the Expiration, Gandi deletes the domain name at the Registry and it goes into Redemption Period for 30 days, and all associated technical services are deleted. The domain name can only be restored during this period in accordance with the terms and conditions described on Our website and/or by as communicated by Our customer service department.

If the domain is neither renewed nor restored within these deadlines, the Registry will delete the domain name, which will become available for registration on a "first come first served" basis.

Section .GL.11. Registrant obligations

You agree to provide and maintain accurate, reliable and up-to-date personal contact information. Failing to do so, the Registry may suspend and/or delete Your domain name.

You acknowledge and agree that distributing malware, abusively operating botnets, phishing, piracy, trademark or copyright infringement, fraudulent or deceptive practices, counterfeiting or otherwise engaging in activity contrary to applicable law are expressly prohibited. Failing to comply with this provision, You expose Yourself to the suspension of Your domain name, in addition to the prosecution for the prejudice caused to third parties and to the

penalties mentioned under applicable law.

You commit Yourself to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Registry and its subcontractors, and their directors, officers, employees, agents and affiliates from and against any and all claims, damages, liabilities, costs, and expenses, including reasonable legal fees and expenses, arising out of or relating to, for any reason whatsoever, the registration of Your domain name. This indemnification obligation shall survive the termination or expiration of the present contract, whatever may be the cause.

Section .GL.12. Rights of the Registry

You acknowledge and accept that the Registry reserves the right to deny, cancel or transfer any registration or transaction, or place any domain name on registry lock, hold (suspension), or similar status as it deems necessary, in its unlimited and sole discretion:

- to enforce the rules and policies established by the Registry and ICANN each as amended from time to time,
- that is not accompanied by complete, accurate, and up-to-date information, or where required information is not updated or corrected, as required by the rules and policies established by the

Registry and ICANN,

- for violation of the present contract or the rules established by the Registry or ICANN,
- to protect the integrity and stability of the domain names system,
- to comply with applicable laws, regulations, policies, government rules or requirements, request of law enforcement or in accordance with an order or decision by a competent court or administrative authority, or any dispute resolution service provider the Registry and ICANN may retain to oversee the arbitration and mediation of disputes,
- to establish, assert, or defend the legal rights of the Registry or a third party, or to avoid any actual or potential civil or criminal liability on the part of or damage to the Registry, its affiliates, subsidiaries, contracted parties, officers, directors, representatives, employees, contractors, and stockholders,
- to correct mistakes made by the Registry or any Registrar in connection to the registration of a domain name,
- as otherwise provided in the terms and conditions and the contracts of the Registry.

The Registry also reserves the right to place Your domain name in « lock » status, « hold » status or similar status during resolution of a dispute.
