

In addition to Gandi Corporate Special Conditions and Gandi's General Terms and Conditions for domain name registration, the registration and use of a domain name in the extension mentioned above imply the acceptance of and compliance to the present special conditions contained herein.

All Your legal information and contracts are presented to You at the time of the subscription to Our services. Capitalized terms have the definition attributed to them in Our General Terms and Conditions of domain name registration. Specifically, "You" refers to the owner of the domain name, and "We" designates Gandi.

## Description of the service

In the framework of its Gandi Corporate service, Gandi allows You to register Your domain name in the extension mentioned above only available to Our Gandi Corporate customers, via the Registrar Tucows Australia (Pty). The following diagram presents the various parties involved in the providing of this service.

When You apply to register a domain name in the proposed extension, You acknowledge that You have fully understood, and You have full knowledge of, and You agree to abide by all the rules and specific conditions of the extension, as defined by the Registry: <u>https://www.auda.org.au/policies</u>.

These contracts are binding between You and the Registry. The special conditions contained herein do not replace these rules, but rather form part of them. You acknowledge to have fully understood and accepted these rules.

In accordance with Our Contracts, You agree to provide and maintain accurate, reliable and up-to-date personal contact information, failing this, the Registry can suspend and/or delete Your domain name or refuse its registration. You consent to the collection, use, publication, in particular in the Registry public <u>Whois</u> database if applicable, and any other processing of Your personal data by the Registry, its technical provider, Tucows Australia (Pty) and their designees and agents for the purposes of providing domain name registration services.

Please note that in accordance with the Registry rules, the provision of the Gandi's anti-spam option is not allowed for .AU domain names.

.COM.AU and .NET.AU domain names are open to Australian registered companies, trading under a registered business name in any Australian state or territory, Australian partnerships or sole traders, foreign companies licensed to trade in Australia, owners of an Australian registered trade mark, applicants for an Australian registered trade mark, associations incorporated in any Australian state or territory, and Australian commercial statutory bodies. The chosen domain name must be identical to Your name as registered with the relevant Australian autorities or to Your trademark, or to their abbreviation or acronym. The domain name may be also closely and substantially connected to Your activity, ie: match to a product that You manufacture or sell, to a service that You provide, to an event that You organise or sponsor, to an activity that You facilitate, teach or train, to a place where You operate, or to a profession that You practise.

.ORG.AU domain names are open to associations incorporated in any Australian state or territory, political parties registered with the Australian Electoral Commission, trade unions or other organizations registered under the Workplace Relations Act 1996, sporting or special interest clubs operating in Australia, charities operating in Australia as defined in their constitution or other documents of incorporation, non-profit organizations operating in Australia as defined in their constitution or other documents of incorporation. The chosen domain name must be identical to Your name as registered with the relevant Australian autorities, or to its abbreviation or acronym. The domain name may be also closely and substantially connected to Your activity, ie match to a service that You provide, to an event that You organise or sponsor, to an activity that You facilitate, teach or train, to a place where You operate, or to a profession that You practise.

If You are a legal person, the individual contact associated to Your Gandi account must be a member or an employee of the legal person.

During the registration process for a .COM.AU, .NET.AU or .ORG.AU domain name, You must indicate:

- Your registration type: ABN (Australian Business Number), ACN (Australian Company Number) or TM (Trademark) if the domain name corresponds to Your trademark, and
- Your registration number corresponding to the registration type declared.

.ID.AU domain names are open to Australian citizen or Australian resident. The chosen domain name must be identical to Your personal name, or to its abbreviation or acronym. The domain name may be also closely and substantially connected to Your activity, ie match to a service that You provide, to an event that You organise or sponsor, to an activity that You facilitate, teach or train, to a place where You operate, or to a profession that You practise, or if the domain name refers to a personal interest or

hobby of the registrant, but the domain name must not be, or incorporate, an entity name, personal name or brand name in existence at the time the domain name was registered.

Under .AU Registry rules, it is prohibited to register a domain name in the .AU zone in the purpose to resell it.

The registration term is from 1 to 5 years. To avoid any suspension of the domain name, the renewal must be paid and funds cleared before the Expiration date. Upon the Expiration date, the domain name is suspended for 29 calendar days, during which time all associated technical services are deactivated. Late renewal at normal price is possible during this period. If the domain is not renewed within these deadlines, the Registry will delete the domain name, which will become available for registration on a "first come first served" basis.
