This indemnification obligation will survive the termination or expiration of the present contract, whatever may be the cause.

You agree to be bound by the terms and conditions of the initial launch of the extension, including without limitation the Sunrise and Landrush periods, the procedure and process for compliance with the ICANN Trademark Clearinghouse and any Sunrise dispute resolution policy, and You acknowledge that the Registry has no liability of any kind for any loss or liability resulting from the proceedings and processes relating to the Sunrise and Landrush periods, including, without limitation:

• the ability or inability to obtain a domain name during these

periods, and

• the results of any dispute over a Sunrise registration.

Section .CASE.17. Rights of the Registry

You acknowledge and accept that the Registry reserves the right to deny, cancel or transfer any registration or transaction, or place any domain name on registry lock, hold (suspension), or similar status as it deems necessary, in its discretion:

- to protect the integrity and stability of the Registry and domain names system,
- to comply with applicable laws, government rules or requirements, requests of law enforcement or any dispute resolution process,
- to avoid any civil or criminal liability on the part of the Registry and its technical operator, and their affiliates, subsidiaries, officers, directors, and employees,
- to correct mistakes made by the Registry or any Registrar in connection to the registration of a domain name,
- per the terms of this agreement.

The Registry also reserves the right to place a domain name in « lock », « hold » or similar status during resolution of a dispute.
