

In addition to Gandi's [General Terms and Conditions](#) of Domain Name Registration, the registration and use of a .IN domain name implies the acceptance of and compliance to the present special conditions.

All Your legal information and contracts can be viewed at any time via Our [website](#). Capitalized terms have the definition attributed to them in our [General Terms and Conditions](#) of Domain Name Registration. Specifically, "You" refers to the owner of the domain name, and "We" designates Gandi. Your current contracts are freely available for viewing when You log into Your account at <http://www.gandi.net/admin/contracts/>.

Section .IN.1. Trustee Authority and Registry

.IN is the official ccTLD of India. The following diagram presents the parties involved and the Trustee Authority for the .IN ccTLD:

When You apply to register a .IN domain name, You acknowledge to have fully understood, and You agree to have full knowledge of and to abide by all the rules and specific conditions of .IN domain names, as defined by the Registry INRegistry, which may be viewed at: <http://www.inregistry.in/policies/>

Before requesting a transfer to Gandi, please be sure that You have the domain's authorization code (supplied by Your current Registrar), and that Your domain name:

- does not have a TransferProhibited status,
- does not expire soon (We recommend that You start the transfer request at least one month before the domain's expiration),
- was created at least 60 days prior to the request, or renewed/transferred at least 7 days prior to the request.

The Expiration date of will remain the same after the transfer. No additional one-year renewal will be added.

Trade (changing the owner during a Registrar transfer) is not available at Gandi.

Section .IN.7. Deletion process

Upon the Expiration of the domain, We suspend (Hold) the domain name for 30 days, during which time all the associated technical services are deactivated. The late renewal at normal prices is possible during this period.

Then the domain goes into Redemption Period for an additional 30 days. It can only be restored during this period, in accordance with the terms and conditions described on Our website and/or by as communicated by Our Customer Care service.

If the domain is neither renewed nor restored within these deadlines, the Registry shall place the domain on "Pending Delete" status for several days, and then delete the domain name, which will become available for registration under the "first-come first-served" basis.
