In addition to Gandi's <u>Domain name registration contract</u>, the registration and use of a .LT domain name implies the acceptance of and compliance to the present special conditions contained herein.

All legal information and contracts can be viewed at any time via Our <u>website</u>. Capitalized terms have the definition attributed to them in Our <u>Domain name registration contract</u>. Specifically, "You" refers to the owner of the domain name, and "We" designates Gandi.

Section .LT.1. Naming organization

.LT is a the official country code Top-Level-Domain (ccTLD) of Lithuania.

Section .LT.2. Registration policies

When You apply to register a .LT domain name, You acknowledge that You have fully understood and You have full knowledge of, and You agree to abide by all the rules and specific conditions of .LT domain names, as defined by **Kaunas University of Technology**, and which may be viewed at the following page:

These policies, that You acknowledge to have fully understood and to have accepted via Our website bind You to the .LT Registry. The present special conditions do not replace these rules, which are incorporated by reference, and are binding on Gandi and You.

Section .LT.3. Special requirements

.LT domain names are open to anyone.

If You are a legal entity, You must provide Your company or organization number when applying for registration.

Section .LT.4. Registration term

The registration is from 1 to 5 years. To avoid any deactivation of the domain name, the renewal must be paid and funds cleared before the Expiration date.

Section .LT.6. Personal data

You consent to the collect, use, copying, distribution, publication, in

particular in the Registry public <u>Whois</u> database if applicable, modification and other processing of Your personal data by the Registry, its technical provider and their designees and agents for the purposes of providing Registry services as defined in the Registry agreement with ICANN and in accordance with the Registry privacy policy.

Section .LT.7. Dispute resolution policy

The Registry has no specific procedure for settling disputes concerning .LT domain names. It is up to the parties to settle the dispute either by amicable agreement or through legal proceedings.

Section .LT.8. Transfer (change of Registrar)

The request for an incoming transfer is initiated via Our Interface.

Before any request, please make sure that:

- You have provided the authorization code associated with the domain name concerned (valid for 7 days). You can find this code at your current Registrar, via the owner account or administrative contact;
- Your domain name does not expire soon (We recommend that you initiate the request at least 1 month before Expiration).

When the transfer is successfully completed, a year is automatically added to the previous expiration date.

Section .LT.9. Ownership change

You must initiate and validate the owner change process on the Registry website. Within the following 7 days, the owner must then formulate the owner change order and proceed with payment on our site

Once the owner change has been completed, you must wait 30 days before you can initiate a new owner change request or a transfer request (change of registrar).

Section .LT.10. Deletion process

The day before the Expiration date, Gandi releases the domain to the Registry. All technical services that may be associated with the domain name are then deactivated.

From this date, the domain is placed in Quarantine status, and can be restored, according to the conditions described on Our Website and/or communicated by Our customer care service. Quarantine lasts for 30 calendar days.

If the domain is neither renewed nor restored within this period, the Registry will delete it, and the domain will become available for registration on a "first come, first served" basis.
