### ANNEX ABOGADO LAW - SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR THE .ABOGADO AND .LAW TLDs

version 2.0 - May 11st, 2023

In addition to Gandi's <u>Domain name registration contract</u>, the registration and use of a domain name under a .ABOGADO or .LAW extension implies the acceptance of and compliance to the present special conditions contained herein.

All legal information and contracts can be viewed at any time via Our <u>website</u>. Capitalized terms have the definition attributed to them in Our <u>Domain name registration contract</u>. Specifically, "You" refers to the owner of the domain name, and "We" designates Gandi.

## Section .ABOGADO\_LAW.1. Naming organization

.ABOGADO and .LAW are generic Top-Level-Domains (gTLD) reserved to legal professionals.

When You apply to register a .ABOGADO or .LAW domain name, You acknowledge that You have fully understood and You have full knowledge of, and You agree to abide by all the rules and specific conditions applicable to .ABOGADO and .LAW, as defined by ICANN and Godaddy Registry, and which may be viewed at the following pages:

## Section .ABOGADO\_LAW.3. Special requirements

.ABOGADO and .LAW extensions are restricted to legal professionals (for example: lawyers, barristers, solicitors, law firms, and other practitioners of law) appropriately licensed to practice law by a recognized accredited body or authorized government authority.

When You register a .ABOGADO or a .LAW domain name, You warrant that You meet the eligibility requirements and You will be the intended beneficiary of the domain name registration.

At any time the Registry may verify whether You continue to meet the eligibility requirements. Where the Registry believes that the

information You provided is out of date, incorrect, or requires further clarification, You have to confirming, updating or explaining the information that is the subject to verification within 14 days. Otherwise the Registry may suspend and/or delete Your domain name.

#### Section .ABOGADO\_LAW.4. Registration term

The registration term is from 1 to 10 years. To avoid any deactivation of the domain name, the renewal must be paid and funds cleared before the Expiration date.

### Section .ABOGADO\_LAW.6. Personal data

You consent to the collect, use, copying, distribution, publication, in particular in the Registry public <u>Whois</u> database if applicable, modification and other processing of Your personal data by the Registry, its technical provider and their designees and agents for the purposes of providing Registry services as defined in the Registry agreement with ICANN and in accordance with the Registry privacy policy.

### Section .ABOGADO LAW.7. Dispute resolution policy

The Registry has adopted the ICANN dispute resolution procedures UDRP (Uniform Dispute Resolution Policy) and URS (Uniform Rapid Suspension System), that You agree fully abide by.

#### Section .ABOGADO LAW.8. Transfer (change of Registrar)

The transfer-in process may be initiated on Our Interface. Before requesting the transfer of the domain name, please make sure You have the domain name's authorization code (supplied by Your current Registrar), and that Your domain name:

- · does not have a TransferProhibited status,
- does not expire soon (We recommend that You start the transfer request at least 1 month prior to its Expiration),
- was created at least 60 days prior to the request,
- has not been transferred within the last 60 days.

Upon successfully transferring a domain name, the registration period is extended by 1 year.

## Section .ABOGADO\_LAW.9. Ownership change

The ownership change process is available on Our Interface and requires the confirmation of both parties by e-mail.

The owner change of a domain name does not change the Expiration date.

## Section .ABOGADO\_LAW.10. Deletion process

Upon the Expiration of the domain name, We suspend (Hold) the domain name for 45 days, during which time all associated technical services are deactivated. Late renewal at normal price is possible during this period.

Then the domain name goes into Redemption Period for an additional 30 days. It can only be restored during this period in accordance with the terms and conditions described on Our website and/or as communicated by Our customer service department.

If the domain name is neither renewed nor restored within these deadlines, the Registry shall place the domain name in "Pending Delete" status for several days, and then delete the domain name, which will become available for registration on a "first-come first-served" basis.

#### Section .ABOGADO LAW.11. Registrant obligations

You agree to provide and maintain accurate, reliable and up-to-date personal contact information. Failing to do so, the Registry may suspend and/or delete Your domain name.

You acknowledge and agree that distributing malware, abusively operating botnets, phishing, piracy, trademark or copyright infringement, fraudulent or deceptive practices, counterfeiting or otherwise engaging in activity contrary to applicable law are expressly prohibited. Failing to comply with this provision, You expose Yourself to the suspension of Your domain name, in addition to the prosecution for the prejudice caused to third parties and to the penalties mentioned under applicable law.

You commit Yourself to indemnify and hold harmless the Registry and its subcontractors, and their employees, directors, officers, representatives, delegates, shareholders, affiliates, agents, successors and assigns from and against any and all losses, claims, damages, liabilities, costs, and expenses, including legal fees and expenses arising out of or relating in any way to Your domain name. This indemnification obligation shall survive the termination or expiration of the present contract, whatever may be the cause.

#### Section .ABOGADO LAW.12. Rights of the Registry

You acknowledge and accept that the Registry reserves the right to deny, cancel or transfer any registration or transaction, or place any domain name on registry lock, hold (suspension), or similar status as it deems necessary, in its unlimited and sole discretion:

- to comply with specifications adopted by any industry group generally recognized as authoritative with respect to the Internet (e.g., RFC),
- to correct mistakes made by the Registry or any Registrar in connection to the registration of a domain name.
- if required by an URS or UDRP proceeding,
- for the non-payment of domain name fees.
