In addition to Gandi's General Terms and Conditions for domain name registration, the registration and use of a .IE domain name implies the acceptance of and compliance to the present special conditions contained herein.

All legal information and contracts can be viewed at any time via Our website. Capitalized terms have the definition attributed to them in Our General Terms and Conditions of domain name registration. Specifically, "You" refers to the owner of the domain name, and "We" designates Gandi.

Section .IE.1. Naming organization

.IE is the official country code Top-Level-Domain (ccTLD) of Ireland.

Section .IE.2. Registration policies

When You apply to register a .IE domain name, You acknowledge that You have fully understood and You have full knowledge of, and You agree to abide by all the rules and specific conditions of .IE domain names, as defined by IE Domain Registry Limited, and which may be viewed at the following page: https://www.weare.ie/our-policies.

These policies, that You acknowledge to have fully understood and to have accepted via Our website bind You to the .IE Registry. The present special conditions do not replace these rules, which are incorporated by reference, and are binding on Gandi and You.

Eligibility conditions

.IE domain names are open to persons having a real and substantive connection with Ireland as specify in Registration and Naming Policy:

You must provide and maintain accurate, reliable and up-to-date personal contact information, failing this the Registry may suspend and/or delete Your domain name.

Registration procedure

During Your registration request, You have to provide the following information:

- The registrant type (Irish company, Irish charity or Other),

- If You are an Irish company, Your CRO number,
 If You are an Irish charity, Your charity number,
 Other registrant type may provide, optionally, any number supporting their eligibility.

In addition, the Registry may require any other supporting information or document in order to prove Your eligibility, in particular Your connection with Ireland. In that case Gandi will contact You by email. These documents will have to be provided to the Registry within 27 days following Your registration request.

When You make Your registration request You accept the conditions of liability and indemnity as established in the Registry

policies and agree to submit to the dispute resolution policy as established by the Registry.

Section .IE.4. Registration term

The registration term is from 1 to 10 years. To avoid any deactivation of the domain name, the renewal must be paid and funds cleared before the Expiration date.

Section .IE.8. Transfer (change of Registrar)

Upon successfully transferring a domain name, the registration period is extended by 1 year.

Section .IE.9. Ownership change

The ownership change process is available on Our Interface and requires the confirmation of both parties by e-mail.

The owner change of a .IE domain name does not change the domain name expiration date.

Section .IE.10. Deletion process

Upon the Expiration of the domain name, We suspend the domain name for 45 days, during which time all associated technical services are deactivated. Late renewal at normal price is possible during this period.

Then the domain name goes into Redemption Period for an additional 30 days. It can only be restored during this period in accordance with the terms and conditions described on Our website and/or as communicated by Our customer service department.

If the domain name is neither renewed nor restored within these deadlines, the Registry shall place the domain name in "Pending Delete" status for several days, and then delete the domain name, \mid served" basis. which will become available for registration on a "first-come first-
