In addition to Gandi's <u>General Terms and Conditions</u> of domain name registration, the registration and use of .EU, .eю and .ευ domain names implies the acceptance of and compliance to the present special conditions.

All Your legal information and contracts can be viewed at any time via Our <u>website</u>. Capitalized terms have the definition attributed to them in Our <u>General Terms and Conditions</u> of domain name registration. Specifically, "You" refers to the owner of the domain name, and "We" designates Gandi.

Section .EU.1. Trustee authority and Registry

.EU is the official country code Top-Level-Domain (ccTLD) of European Union.

.eio is the official ccTLD of European Union in Cyrillic characters. .eu is the official ccTLD of European Union in Greek characters.

Section .EU.2. Registration terms and conditions

When You apply to register a .EU, a .eio or .ɛu domain name, You acknowledge You have fully understood and You have full knowledge of, and You agree to abide by all the rules and specific conditions of .EU, .eio and .ɛu domain names, as defined by EURid, and which may be viewed at the following page:

- individuals residing within the European Union, Norway, Iceland or Liechtenstein, or having their citizenship in one of these countries
- business having its registered office, central administration or principal place of business within the European Union, Norway,

Iceland or Liechtenstein,

 organizations established within the European Union, Norway, Iceland or Liechtenstein.

.eio domain names are available in Cyrillic characters only, and .εu domain names in Greek characters only. .EU domain names are not available in Cyrillic and Greek characters.

.ευ opening

The rules applicable to the opening of .ɛu that occurs the 14 November, 2019 are available to the following address: https://eurid.eu/fr/register-a-eu-domain/guidelines-eu-greek

In the framework of the opening of $.\epsilon u$, .EU domain names in Greek are no longer available to registration.

In the framework of these new rules, the Registry has allocated to the current holders of a .EU domain name in Greek characters the domain name corresponding in .ɛu free of charge for 3 years. The 2 corresponding domain names can be managed as any domain name independently of each other.

However, if the .ɛu domain name the Registry has allocated You is deleted, it will not become available to registration (for anyone including You) as long as the corresponding .EU domain name has not been deleted too. If the .EU domain name is deleted, it will never become available to registration.

At the end of this 3 years period, .EU domain names in Greek characters will be definitively deleted.

Section .EU.5. Registration term

The registration term is from 1 to 10 years. To avoid any deletion of the domain name, the renewal must be paid and done before the Expiration date.

Section .EU.7. Storage of contact information

Gandi acts as a sub-contractor of the Registry, responsible for collecting the technical and personal data needed for the registration of Your domain name, and which will be processed as such by the Registry.

You declare to have fully understood and to agree to fully abide by these rules.

Personal data is collected to enable the registration and management of Your domain name. Personal data shall be sent to EURid, incorporated into its database, and published in the public Whois directory when applicable. This directory may be accessed for example on Our website (https://www.gandi.net/whois) or on EURid's website (https://eurid.eu/en).

Section .EU.8. Dispute resolution policy

You accept that any dispute related to Your domain name will be bound by these ADR rules in the event of a dispute between You and a third party pertaining the registration and/or use of a domain name, or with the Registry, to go contest a decision made by the Registry.

These rules are an integral part of Your contract with EURid and to the present special conditions. You acknowledge to have fully understood and agree to abide by these rules. These alternative rules do not hinder the judicial or arbitral procedures of disputes related to domain names in accordance with Gandi's general terms and conditions of domain name registration.

Section .EU.9. Transfer (change of Registrar)

The process is started on Our Interface. Before requesting the transfer of the domain, please be sure that:

- You have the domain's authorization code (supplied by Your current Registrar and valid 40 days),
- Your domain name does not expire soon (We recommend that You start the transfer request at least 1 month prior to its Expiration).

The transfer's completion requires Your confirmation (by e-mail).

Upon successfully transferring a domain, the registration period is extended by one year.

It is not possible to set a Transfer Prohibited status at Gandi on .EU, .eo and .ɛu domain names in order to avoid transfers.

Section .EU.10. Ownership change

The ownership change process is available on Our Interface, it requires the confirmation of the two parties (current and new

owners) by e-mail.

The owner change of .EU, .eio and .eu domain names at Gandi does not change the domain's Expiration date.

Section .EU.11. Deletion process

Upon the Expiration of the domain, the domain name is released by Gandi to the Registry. All associated technical services are deactivated.

At this time, the domain name is placed on Quarantine status and can be restored, in accordance with the terms and conditions described on Our website and/or as communicated by Our customer service department. The length of the Quarantine period is 40 calendar days.

If the domain is neither renewed nor restored within these deadlines, the Registry will delete the domain name, which will become available for registration on a "first come first served" basis.

Section .EU.12. Your declarations and guarantees

You agree to provide and maintain accurate, reliable and up-to-date personal contact information. Failing to do so, the Registry may delete Your domain name.

During Your registration request, You:

- confirm that You satisfy the eligibility criteria as specify in the article 3 of the present contract,
- affirm that to Your knowledge Your registration request is made in good faith and does not infringe any rights of third parties,
- undertake that You shall abide all the terms and conditions for registration, including the policy relative to the Alternative Dispute Resolution Policy established by EURid as specified in the article 8 of the present contract.

We call Your attention to the fact that, in addition to the liability that You expose Yourself to in the event of an infringement of the rights of a third party or Your legal and contractual obligations, the rules that bind You to EURid interpret each breach of contract on Your part as justification for a denial of registration, the suspension or deletion of Your domain name by EURid, without Our ability to intervene.

Section .EU.13. EURid action on domain names (hold, lock and revocation)

Pursuant to EURid rules, You authorize EURid to intervene on the status of Your domain name and in particular to:

- hold (deactivate) the domain, for example if it is not renewed on time.
- lock (block) the domain, for example in the event of a judicial or ADR procedure,
- revoke the domain, for example after implementation of an ADR decision, for lack of payment, infringement of the eligibility criteria or any other infringement on Your part of EURid rules.

As technical sub-contractor and in accordance with EURid rules which You and Gandi must comply with, We have absolutely no control over the status if it was changed by EURid.
