

## Special conditions for additional extensions under the Gandi Corporate service specific for the extension .AU

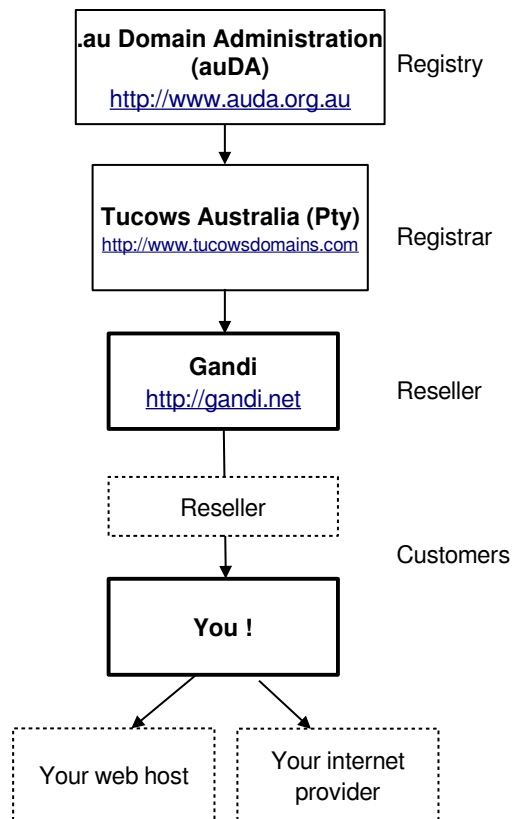
In addition to Gandi Corporate Special Conditions and Gandi's General Terms and Conditions for domain name registration, the registration and use of a domain name in the extension mentioned above imply the acceptance of and compliance to the present special conditions contained herein.

All Your legal information and contracts are presented to You at the time of the subscription to Our Services. Capitalized terms have the definition attributed to them in Our General Terms and Conditions of Domain Name Registration. Specifically, "You" refers to the owner of the domain name, and "We" designates Gandi.

### Description of the service

In the framework of its Gandi Corporate service, Gandi allows You to register Your domain name in the extension mentioned above only available to Our Gandi Corporate customers, via the Registrar Tucows Australia (Pty). The following diagram presents the various parties involved in the providing of this service.



When You apply to register a domain name in the proposed extension, You acknowledge that You have fully understood, and that You certify to have full knowledge of and that You agree to abide by all the rules and specific conditions of the extension, as defined by the Registry: <https://www.auda.org.au/policies>

These contracts are binding between You and the Registry. The special conditions contained herein do not replace these rules, but rather form part of them. You acknowledge to have fully understood and accepted these rules.

In accordance with Our Contracts, You agree to provide and maintain accurate, reliable and up-to-date personal contact information, failing this, the Registry can delete Your domain name or refuse its registration. You also accept that the Registry and Tucows can access Your personal contact information and display it in the public Whois database.

Please note that in accordance with the Registry rules, the provision of the Gandi's Whois privacy and anti-spam options is not allowed for .AU domain names.

.COM.AU and .NET.AU domain names are open to legal persons, trading, partnerships or sole traders registered in Australia, to foreign companies licensed to trade in Australia and to owners or applicants of an Australian registered trademark. The chosen domain name must be identical to Your name as registered with the relevant Australian authorities or to Your trademark, or to their abbreviation or acronym. The domain name may be also closely and substantially connected to Your activity, ie match to a product that You manufacture or sell, to a service that You provide, to an event that You organise or sponsor, to an activity that You facilitate, teach or train, to a place where You operate, or to a profession that You practise.

If You are a legal person, the individual contact associated to Your Gandi account must be a member or an employee of the legal person.

During the registration process, You must indicate:

- Your registration type: ABN (Australian Business Number), ACN (Australian Company Number) or TM (Trademark) if the domain name corresponds to Your trademark, and
- Your registration number corresponding to the registration type declared.

.ORG.AU domain names are open to associations incorporated in any Australian State or Territory, political parties registered with the Australian Electoral Commission, trade unions or other organizations registered under the Workplace Relations Act 1996, sporting or special interest clubs operating in Australia, charities operating in Australia as defined in their constitution or other documents of incorporation, non-profit organizations operating in Australia as defined in their constitution or other documents of incorporation. The chosen domain name must be identical to Your name as registered with the relevant Australian authorities, or to its abbreviation or acronym. The domain name may be also closely and substantially connected to Your activity, ie match to a service that You provide, to an event that You organise or sponsor, to an activity that You facilitate, teach or train, to a place where You operate, or to a profession that You practise.

Under the .AU Registry rules, You do not acquire property rights of the domain name registered but rather that You are granted user rights of the domain name. It is prohibited to register a domain name in the .AU zone in the purpose to resell it.

The registration term is 2 years. To avoid any deletion of the domain name, the renewal must be paid and funds cleared **no later than 2 days before the Expiration date. One day before the Expiration date**, the domain name is released by Gandi to the Registry. At this time, the domain name is placed in Quarantine status and can be restored, in accordance with the terms and conditions described on Our website and/or as communicated by Our Corporate team. The length of the Quarantine period is 3 calendar days. If the domain is neither renewed nor restored within these deadlines, the Registry will delete the domain name, which will become available for registration on a "first come first served" basis.
