

ANNEX .GLOBAL - SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR THE .GLOBAL TLD

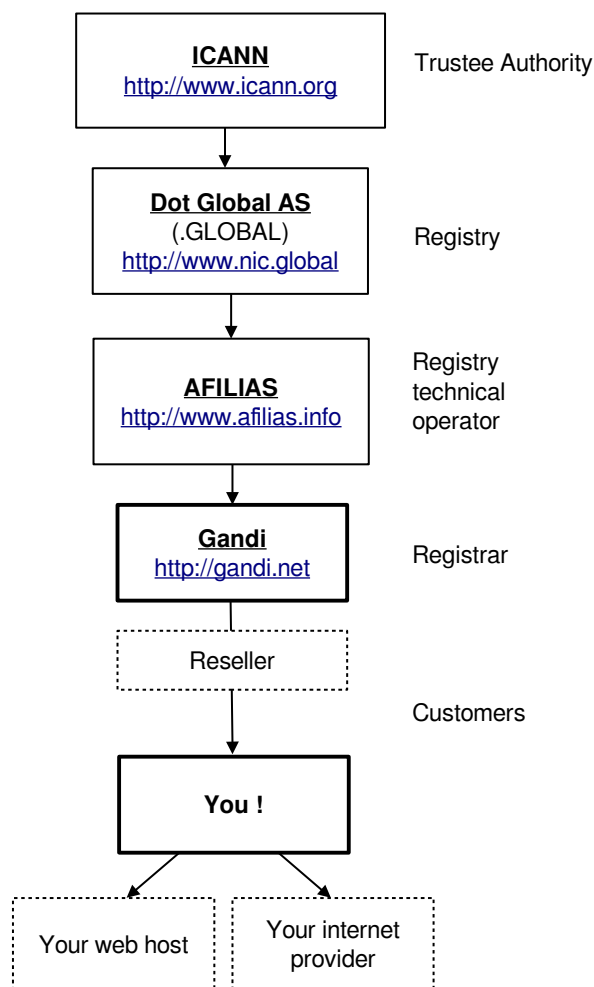

In addition to Gandi's [General Terms and Conditions](#) for domain name registration, the registration and use of a .GLOBAL domain name implies the acceptance of and compliance to the present special conditions contained herein.

All Your legal information and contracts can be viewed at any time via Our [website](#). Capitalized terms have the definition attributed to them in Our [General Terms and Conditions](#) of Domain Name Registration. Specifically, "You" refers to the owner of the domain name, and "We" designates Gandi.

Section .GLOBAL.1. Trustee authority and Registry

.GLOBAL is a generic Top-Level-Domain (gTLD) which aims is to have a universal coverage and is open to anyone. The following diagram presents the various parties involved for the .GLOBAL TLD:

Section .GLOBAL.2. Registration terms and conditions

When You apply to register a .GLOBAL domain name, You acknowledge that You have fully understood, and that You certify to have full knowledge of and that You agree to abide by all the rules and specific conditions of .GLOBAL domain names, as defined by ICANN and Dot Global AS and which may be viewed at the following pages:

These contracts bind You to the .GLOBAL Registry. The special conditions contained herein do not replace these rules, but rather form part of them. You acknowledge to have fully understood and to have accepted these rules on Our website.

Section .GLOBAL.3. Special requirements

.GLOBAL domain names are open to anyone.

Section .GLOBAL.4. Reserved names

Some words are reserved or prohibited:

- ICANN terms:
<http://www.icann.org/en/about/agreements/registries/global> (specification 5. schedule of reserved names),
- names containing two characters followed by two hyphens and names beginning or ending by a hyphen are not allowed,
- labels connected to the International Olympic Committee, International Red Cross and Red Crescent Movement and Intergovernmental Organizations categories have been reserved,
- the ASCII label "EXAMPLE" shall be withheld from registration or allocated to the .GLOBAL Registry at the second level and at all other levels within the TLD at which the .GLOBAL Registry offers registration,
- two-character labels. All two-character labels shall be withheld from registration or allocated to .GLOBAL Registry at the second level within the TLD. Such labels may not be activated in the DNS, and may not be released for registration to any person or entity other than the .GLOBAL Registry, provided that such two-character label strings may be released to the extent that the .GLOBAL Registry reaches agreement with the related government and country-code manager of the string as specified in the ISO 3166-1 alpha-2 standard,
- in accordance with .GLOBAL Acceptable Use Policy, labels which are identified as abusive, racist, obscene or terms related to crime or offenses will be prevented from registration. The .GLOBAL Registry can, at its own discretion, remove registered labels within these terms. The .GLOBAL Registry, has a "Registry Block List" of labels which fall into the above categories that have been blocked from registration by the .GLOBAL Registry. This list may be amended at the discretion of the .GLOBAL Registry.

Section .GLOBAL.5. Registration term

The registration term is from 1 to 10 years. To avoid any deactivation of the domain name, the renewal must be paid and

funds cleared **before the Expiration date.**

“Premium” domain names are subject to specific prices as indicated on Our interface during Your order.

Section .GLOBAL.7. Storage of contact information

In application of ICANN contracts, all personal and technical information associated with the registration of Your domain name is recorded and made available to ICANN and IRON MOUNTAIN (ICANN's designated Registrar Data Escrow agent), in addition to messages pertaining to each registration or modification, during the entire duration of the registration of the domain name, plus the two following years.

You accept that the Registry can access Your personal contact information and display it in the public [Whois](#) database.

Section .GLOBAL.8. Dispute resolution policy

The Registry has adopted the ICANN dispute resolution procedures UDRP (Uniform Dispute Resolution Policy) and URS (Uniform Rapid Suspension System) for .GLOBAL domains, that You agree fully abide by.

You also agree to submit to any other dispute resolution mechanism imposed by ICANN and/or organized by the Registry.

Section .GLOBAL.9. Transfer (change of Registrar)

The transfer-in process may be initiated on Our Interface. Before requesting the transfer of the domain, please make sure You have the domain's authorization code (supplied by Your current Registrar), and that Your domain name:

- does not have a TransferProhibited status,
- does not expire soon (We recommend that You start the transfer request at least 1 month prior to its Expiration),
- was created at least 60 days prior to the request,
- has not been transferred within the last 60 days.

The transfer's completion requires Your confirmation (by e-mail).

Upon successfully transferring a domain, the registration period is extended by one year.

Section .GLOBAL.10. Ownership change

The ownership change process is available on Our Interface and requires the confirmation of both parties by e-mail.

The owner change of a domain name does not change the domain's expiration date.

Section .GLOBAL.11. Deletion process

Upon the Expiration of the domain, We suspend (Hold) the domain name for 45 days, during which time all associated technical services are deactivated. Late renewal at normal price is possible during this period.

Then the domain goes into Redemption Period for an additional 30 days, and all associated technical services are deactivated. It can only be restored during this period in accordance with the terms and conditions described on Our website and/or as communicated by Our customer service department.

If the domain is neither renewed nor restored within these deadlines, the Registry shall place the domain on “Pending Delete” status for several days, and then delete the domain name, which will become available for registration on a “first-come first-served” basis.

Section .GLOBAL.12. Registrant representations and guarantees

You agree to provide and maintain accurate, reliable and up-to-date personal contact information. Failing to do so, the Registry may delete Your domain name.

By submitting a registration or modification request You acknowledge that:

- You will assume sole responsibility for the registration and use of Your domain name,
- You must provide accurate information for publication in directories such as WHOIS, and promptly update this to reflect any changes,
- You must respond to inquiries from Your Registrar within fifteen (15) days, and keep Your Gandi account data current. If You chose to have Your domain name registration renew automatically, You must also keep Your payment information current

In addition, by submitting a request during the Sunrise period, You acknowledge that the Registry and/or its agents are authorized to share information relating to Your request to TMCH, other Sunrise applicants, and/or any third party.

In any case, You acknowledge and agree that distributing malware, abusively operating botnets, phishing, piracy, trademark or copyright infringement, fraudulent or deceptive practices, counterfeiting or otherwise engaging in activity contrary to applicable law are expressly prohibited. Failing to comply with this provision, You expose Yourself to the suspension of Your domain name, in addition to the prosecution for the prejudice caused to third parties and to the penalties mentioned under applicable law.

You commit Yourself To indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Registry, and its subcontractors, and the directors, officers, employees, affiliates and agents of each of them, from and against any and all claims damages, liabilities, costs and expenses, including reasonable legal fees and expenses, arising out of or relating to Your domain name registration. This indemnification obligation shall survive the termination of the present contract,

whatever may be the cause, and is the direct consequence of Our accreditation agreement.

Section .GLOBAL.13. Exclusion of liability and actions of the Registry

You expressly acknowledge and accept that the Registry shall be entitled, that it deems necessary, in its sole and entire discretion, but not obligated, to reject, delete, suspend, transfer to a third party or place in "lock" status, "hold" status or similar status Your domain name:

- to enforce the Registry's policies and ICANN requirements, each as amended from time to time
- where the application or registration is not in compliance with any other provision of the Launch Policy Rules of the Registry
- To protect the integrity and stability of the Shared Registry System, and/or the operation and/or management of the .GLOBAL domain extension; or
- in order to comply with the political constitution, applicable laws,

regulations, resolutions of Ireland, and/or any decision by a competent court or administrative authority and/or any dispute resolution service provider the Registry may hereafter retain to oversee the arbitration and mediation of disputes; and/or any other applicable laws, regulations, policies or decrees; or

- to establish, assert, defend the legal rights of the Registry or a third party, or to avoid any actual or potential civil or criminal liability on the part of or damage to the Registry or its affiliates, subsidiaries, contracted parties, officers, directors, representatives, employees, contractors, and stockholders; or
- following the outcome of a Sunrise Dispute Resolution Request or a Registration Eligibility Dispute Resolution Request; or
- to correct mistakes made by the Registry or any Registrar in connection with a registration.

The Registry also reserves the right to place Your domain name in « lock » status, « hold » status or similar status during resolution of a dispute.
