

ANNEX .IM - SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR THE .IM ccTLD

version 1.4 – May the 9th, 2023

In addition to Gandi's [Domain name registration contract](#), the registration and use of a .IM domain name implies the acceptance of and compliance to the present special conditions contained herein.

All legal information and contracts can be viewed at any time via Our [website](#). Capitalized terms have the definition attributed to them in Our [Domain name registration contract](#). Specifically, “You” refers to the owner of the domain name, and “We” designates Gandi.

Section .IM.1. Naming organization

.IM is the official country code Top-Level-Domain (ccTLD) of the Isle of Man.

Section .IM.2. Registration policies

When You apply to register a .IM domain name, You acknowledge that You have fully understood and You have full knowledge of, and You agree to abide by all the rules and specific conditions of .IM domain names, as defined by Domicilium (IOM) Limited, and which may be viewed at the following pages:

These policies, that You acknowledge to have fully understood and to have accepted via Our website bind You to the .IM Registry. The present special conditions do not replace these rules, which are incorporated by reference, and are binding on Gandi and You.

Section .IM.3. Special requirements

.IM domain names are open to anyone.

Words included on the .IM Black List (this list is not public), undesirable words, and words which are connected to regulated activities on the Isle of Man are not available to registration. Applicants for a domain name that is rejected for these reasons may appeal within 10 days of the rejection notice, stating the reasons why the name should be approved, by using the appeal process available on the .IM Registry website.

You agree to provide and maintain accurate, reliable and up-to-date personal contact information. Failing to do so, the Registry may suspend and/or delete Your domain name. The Registry may request certain information from You regarding Your legal identity when You make an application for or seek to amend the registration of a domain name.

The Registry reserves the right to check Your application for compliance with the rules either before or after Your domain name is registered or renewed. The Registry reserves the right to refuse the registration of domain names and revoke domain names at the request of a competent authority.

Section .IM.4. Registration term

The registration term is from 1 to 2 years. To avoid any deactivation of the domain name, the renewal must be paid and funds cleared before the Expiration date.

1 and 2 character domain names are subject to a specific pricing as indicated on Our interface during Your order.

Section .IM.6. Personal data

You consent to the collect, use, copying, distribution, publication, in particular in the Registry public [Whois](#) database if applicable, modification and other processing of Your personal data by the Registry, its technical provider and their designees and agents for the purposes of providing domain name registration services and in accordance with the Registry privacy policy.

Section .IM.7. Dispute resolution policy

The Registry has adopted a dispute resolution procedure for .IM domain names, that You agree fully abide by.

Section .IM.8. Transfer

The process is started on Our Interface. Before requesting the transfer of the domain name, please be sure that You have the domain name's authorization code (supplied by Your current Registrar), and that Your domain name:

- does not have a TransferProhibited status,
- does not expire soon (We recommend that You start the transfer request at least 1 month prior to its Expiration).

The transfer of a domain name does not change the domain name expiration date.

Section .IM.9. Ownership change

The ownership change process is available on Our Interface and requires the confirmation of both parties by e-mail.

The owner change of a domain name does not change the Expiration date.

Section .IM.10. Deletion process

Upon the Expiration of the domain name, the domain name is suspend (Hold) for 28 days, during which time all associated technical services are deactivated. Late renewal at normal price is possible during this period.

If the domain name is not renewed within these deadlines, the Registry will delete the domain name, which will become available for registration on a “first come first served” basis.
