

ANNEX .RO - SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR THE .RO ccTLD



In addition to Gandi's [General Terms and Conditions](#) for domain name registration, the registration and use of a .RO domain name implies the acceptance of and compliance to the present special conditions contained herein.

All Your legal information and contracts can be viewed at any time via Our [website](#). Capitalized terms have the definition attributed to them in Our [General Terms and Conditions](#) of Domain Name Registration. Specifically, "You" refers to the owner of the domain name, and "We" designates Gandi.

Section .RO.1. Trustee authority and Registry

.RO is the official country code Top-Level-Domain (ccTLD) of Romania. The following diagram presents the various parties involved and the Trustee Authority for the .RO TLD:



You can view the information and special rules of each party involved by clicking on the respective links.

Section .RO.2. Registration terms and conditions

When You apply to register a .RO domain name, You acknowledge that You have fully understood, and that You certify to have full knowledge of and that You agree to abide by all the rules and specific conditions of .RO domain names, as defined by ICI, and which may be viewed at the following pages:

These contracts are binding between You and the .RO Registry. The special conditions contained herein do not replace these rules, but rather form part of them. You acknowledge to have fully understood and accepted these rules on Our website.

Section .RO.3. Special requirements

.RO special requirements are available at:

.RO domain names are open to anyone.

During the registration of Your domain name on Our website, You shall have to indicate:

- Your entity type (individual, commercial company, non-profit organization ...),
- for legal persons: Your registration number and if You are in the European Union Your fiscal code (VAT number...),
- for individuals: Your ID number (passport number...).

The Registry may request additional documents for the registration of Your domain name or refuse the registration of Your domain name in particular in case of non compliance with .RO rules. The Registry may also, in its sole discretion, delete a domain name within 30 days from the receipt of the payment by the Registry.

You agree to provide and maintain accurate, reliable and up-to-date personal contact information, failing this the .RO Registry can delete Your domain name.

You allow to the Registry to perform "zonecheck" for Your domain name (at the end of each month, in order to collect errors and domain name statistics).

Section .RO.4. Registration term

The registration term is from 1 to 10 years. To avoid any deletion of the domain name, the renewal must be paid and funds cleared **no later than 2 days before the Expiration date**,

Section .RO.6. Storage of contact information

You consent to the collection, use, copying, distribution, publication in the public [Whois](#) database, modification and other processing of Your personal data by the Registry.

However, the personal data of the natural persons is not displayed in public Whois database.

Section .RO.7. Dispute resolution policy

The .RO Registry has adopted the ICANN Uniform Dispute Resolution Policy (UDRP) for .RO domains, that You agree fully abide by:

Section .RO.8. Transfer (change of Registrar)

The process is started on Our Interface. Before requesting the transfer of the domain, please be sure that:

- You have the domain's authorization code (« Transfer Authorization Key »). This code must be retrieved on the [Registry interface](#),
- Your domain name is not in « reserved » status,
- Your domain name does not have a TransferProhibited status,
- Your domain name does not expire soon (We recommend that You start the transfer request at least 1 month prior to its Expiration).

The transfer's completion requires Your confirmation (by e-mail).

The transfer of a .RO domain name does not change the domain's Expiration date.

Section .RO.9. Ownership change

Before requesting the owner change of the domain, please be sure that:

- You have the domain's authorization code (« Trade Authorization Key »). This code must be retrieved on the [Registry interface](#),
- Your domain name is not in « reserved » status,
- Your domain name does not have a TransferProhibited status,
- Your domain name does not expire soon (We recommend that

You start the transfer request at least 1 month prior to its Expiration).

The owner change process requires:

- the Gandi owner change form completed and signed with Your ID documents that must be send to Gandi,
- a signed letter with Your ID documents that must be sent to the Registry in order to complete the owner change.

The creation date is reset at the Registry, and any remaining period is lost.

Section .RO.10. Deletion process

One day before the Expiration date, the domain name is released by Gandi to the Registry. All associated technical services are removed.

At this time, the domain name is placed in Quarantine status and can be restored, in accordance with the terms and conditions described on Our website and/or as communicated by Our customer service department. The length of the Quarantine period is 90 calendar days.

If the domain is neither renewed nor restored within these deadlines, the Registry will delete the domain name, which will become available for registration on a "first come first served" basis.
